## Access to Transform

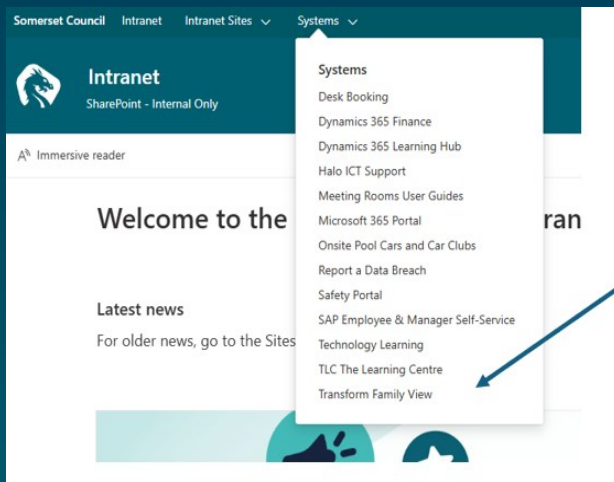
Do you work in Childrens Social Care, FIS, Education or Public Health and not yet have access to Transform Family View.

# Children at risk of leaving School Early (NEET Tool)

NEET LIKELIHOOD SCORE		REASONS	
The model has predicted this person has:		<b>Vulnerability</b>	<b>Explanation</b>
Number of Vulnerabilities	NEET Likelihood	Issues with attendance	The individual has had poor attendance, below 90% in their year 10 school year.
12+	Very High Likelihood	Excluded	The individual has not been excluded during their academic journey.
8 to 11	High Likelihood	Unauthorised Absence	The individual has not been absent for 5% or more of their year 10 school year.
5 to 7	Some Likelihood	PRU	The individual has not attended a PRU during their academic journey.
2 to 4	Low Likelihood	SEND - Educational	The individual has learning SEND difficulties.
Up to 1	Very Low Likelihood	SEND - Emotional	The individual has emotional, social/behaviour SEND difficulties.
<b>LIKELIHOOD SCORE EXPLANATION</b> The Model has predicted that this person is at a Very High Likelihood of being NEET. This score has been given because typically 50% or more of students in a similar situation went on to become NEET. This is only a tool to aid with decision making, everyone has some risk of becoming NEET and therefore professional judgement is more important than the recommendations of the model.		Historic Absence	The individual has had historically high number of unauthorised absences during years 7, 8 and 9.
		Historic Attendance	The individual has had historically poor attendance during years 7, 8 and 9.
		Suspensions	The individual has not received a suspension during their year 10 school year.
		Historic Suspensions	The individual has not received a suspension during their year 7, 8, or 9 school year.
		Victim of Crime	The individual has not been recorded by the police as a victim of crime.
		Perpetrator of Crime	The individual has been recorded by the police as a perpetrator of a crime.
		Free School Meals	The individual has not been in receipt of free school meals over the years.
		Benefits	Adult in the household has been in receipt of benefits.

You have been given access to the Somerset NEET 'Likelihood of Leaving School Early' tool incorporated into Transform Family View, this has been sighted in the government's 'Get Britain Working' white paper.

We are really proud of this in Somerset created by our in house data scientist's, so if you work with children from Year 7 upwards and want to understand their 'likelihood of being an 'early school leaver to better support them remaining in Education. The links within the tool to resources from Bath University will be a helpful support with your work.

## Sharing the Learning

Driving national change in Children's Services requires collaboration, innovation, and a focus on outcomes for children and families. As Service Manager for Partnership Transformation, I've supported Local Authorities nationally with digital transformation and sector-led improvement.

A key initiative of interest has been creating Transform Family View, which enhances safeguarding and early intervention. Somerset Council's use of AI in Children's Services, highlighted at a recent RIP conference, drew significant interest. Working with national bodies like the MoJ, DfE, ICO has improved guidance, analytics, and cross-boundary collaboration, helping overcome barriers to digital transformation and information sharing.

The impact of this work is clear: improved outcomes for families, stronger multi-agency partnerships, and national recognition for innovative approaches. By sharing learning and supporting colleagues across the sector, we're building a culture of continuous improvement - one that puts children and families at the heart of everything we do.
